OBJECTION TO PETITION FOR GUARDIANSHIP OF THE PERSON

NOW COMES *** ***, ***, MA, the daughter of ***** and an interested party to these proceedings, and objects to the Petition for Guardian of the Person of ***** (the "Ward").

AS REASONS, the objector states:

1. She was given a Durable Power of Attorney (executed on June *, 200*) by the Ward, giving her the authority to "arrange from time to time for any medical and/or nursing care" for the Ward as may be appropriate and nominating her to be appointed guardian should the Honorable Court deem such an appointment necessary;
2. The objector agrees and assents to the placement of the Ward in a nursing home or rehabilitative care facility in or around the ****-, as has been or may be recommended by the physicians at ***** Hospital, in which case there is or will be no need for a guardian; and

The objector further states that should the Honorable Court determine that the appointment of a permanent guardian is necessary, that she or a neutral third party be so appointed.
